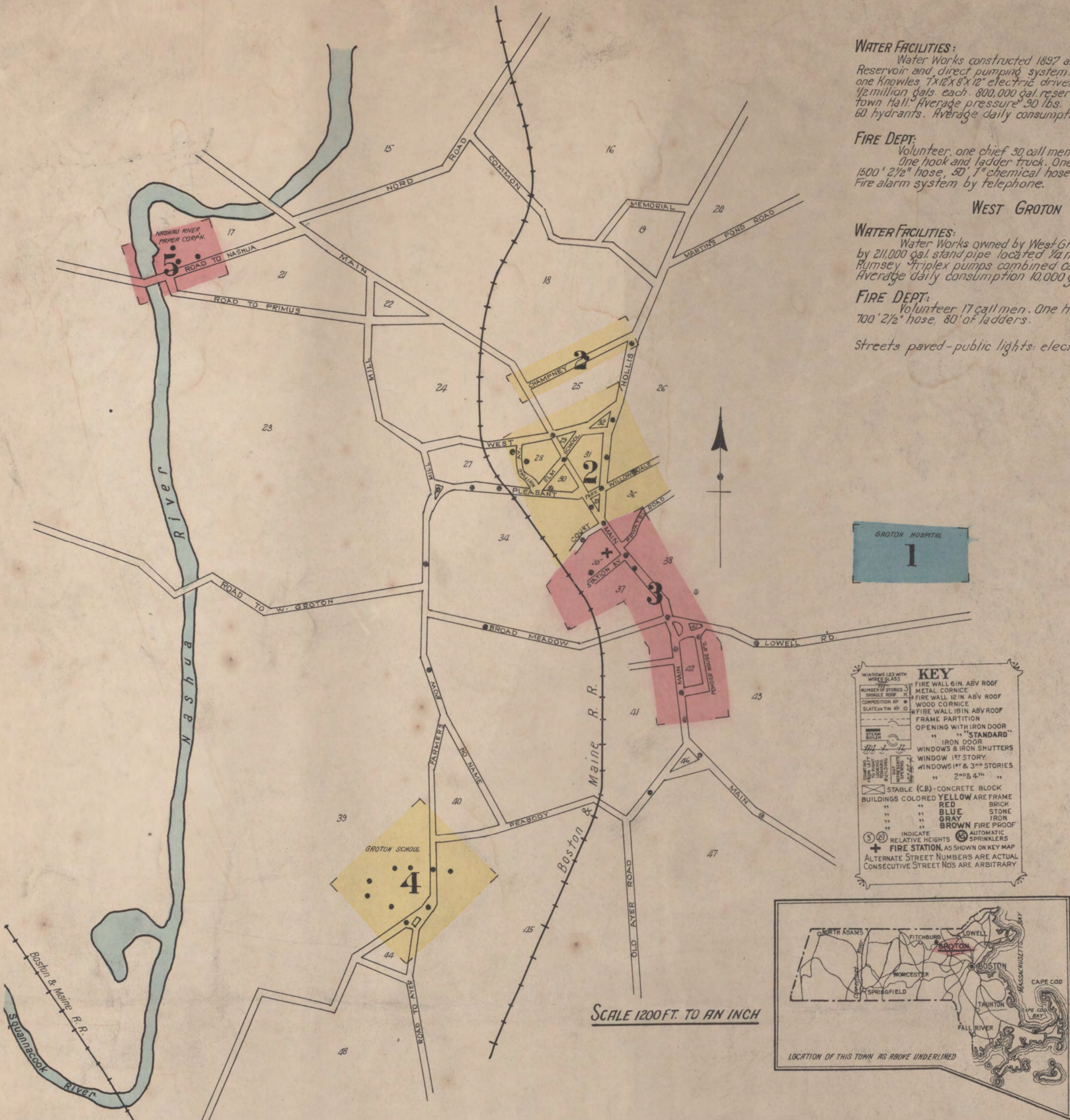
**GROTON SCHOOL**

#### WATER FACILITIES:

Water Works constructed 1897 and owned by Groton Water Co. Reservoir and direct pumping system. One Platt triplex 10"x12" and one Knowles 7x12x8x12" electric driven steam aux pumps capacity 1/2 million gals. each. 800,000 gal. reservoir located 3/4 miles east of town hall. Average pressure 30 lbs. 10 miles 2" to 12" water mains. 60 hydrants. Average daily consumption 100,000 gallons.

#### FIRE DEPT:

Volunteer, one chief, 30 call men. One motor comb. hose and chem. One hook and ladder truck. One hand engine. One hose wagon. 1800' 2 1/2" hose, 50' 1" chemical hose. 24 chemical extinguishers. Fire alarm system by telephone.

#### WEST GROTON

#### WATER FACILITIES:

Water Works owned by West Groton Water Co. Water supplied by 2 1/2" gal. stand pipe located 1/4 mile N. of Post Office. Two Ramsey triplex pumps combined capacity 253,000 gals. per 24 hours. Average daily consumption 10,000 gals.

#### FIRE DEPT:

Volunteer 17 call men. One hand engine, one hose reel. 100' 2 1/2" hose, 80' of ladders.

Streets paved - public lights - electric - No fire limits.
